

## Competition Rules

### General rules:

Entry deadline: 2013. November 20.

A fence will be between the two courses.

The surface of the course is compacted sand.

Box judges are from the teams of the previous race.

### Beginner class:

A beginner team consists of 2 dogs, both dogs run in the heats.

Beginner teams do not need to give a seed time.

Minimum age is 12 months. Jump heights are 17,5 cm.

Beginners can use working/not working flyball box or shoot (chute).

Any help for the dogs is allowed but it cannot be unsafe and cannot disturb the other team. Team leaders must report the judge before the race if help is going to be used.

Any dog can compete in beginner class that has not competed before (in Hungary or abroad) at a flyball competition.

There will be training opportunities in the morning depending on the number of teams. Warm-up before each race is 3 minutes.

Competition schedule: Speed Trial/Round Robin, then Double Elimination by divisions.

### Official class:

The competition is arranged by EFC rules.

Submitting seed times is as it was before.

**Help:** it is allowed to help the dogs for 1 sec time penalty per each helped dog, usage of help must be reported to the main judge before the race.

There is no training at the competition. Warm-up before the first race is 5 minutes long, and for all other races it is 2 minutes.

Competition schedule: Round Robin or Speed Trial depending on the number of entries, then Double Elimination.

### Seed Time and Break Out rules:

In each phase of the competition max. 2 BO is allowed. If the team has a 3<sup>rd</sup> BO they cannot get placed.
